In 2006, five manufacturers in the sunroom industry sat down to discuss the importance of creating an organization that supported the advancement of the manufacture and construction of safe, energy efficient and environmentally conscious, code compliant sunrooms, patio rooms and solariums. Through this and a series of meetings, the Canadian Sunroom Manufacturers Association was created and incorporated in 2007. The primary focus at the time of inception has been to tackle issues related to building code limitations across Canada. As the membership grows, the Association will respond to the important issues that arise out of meetings, dealer surveys and the industry itself.

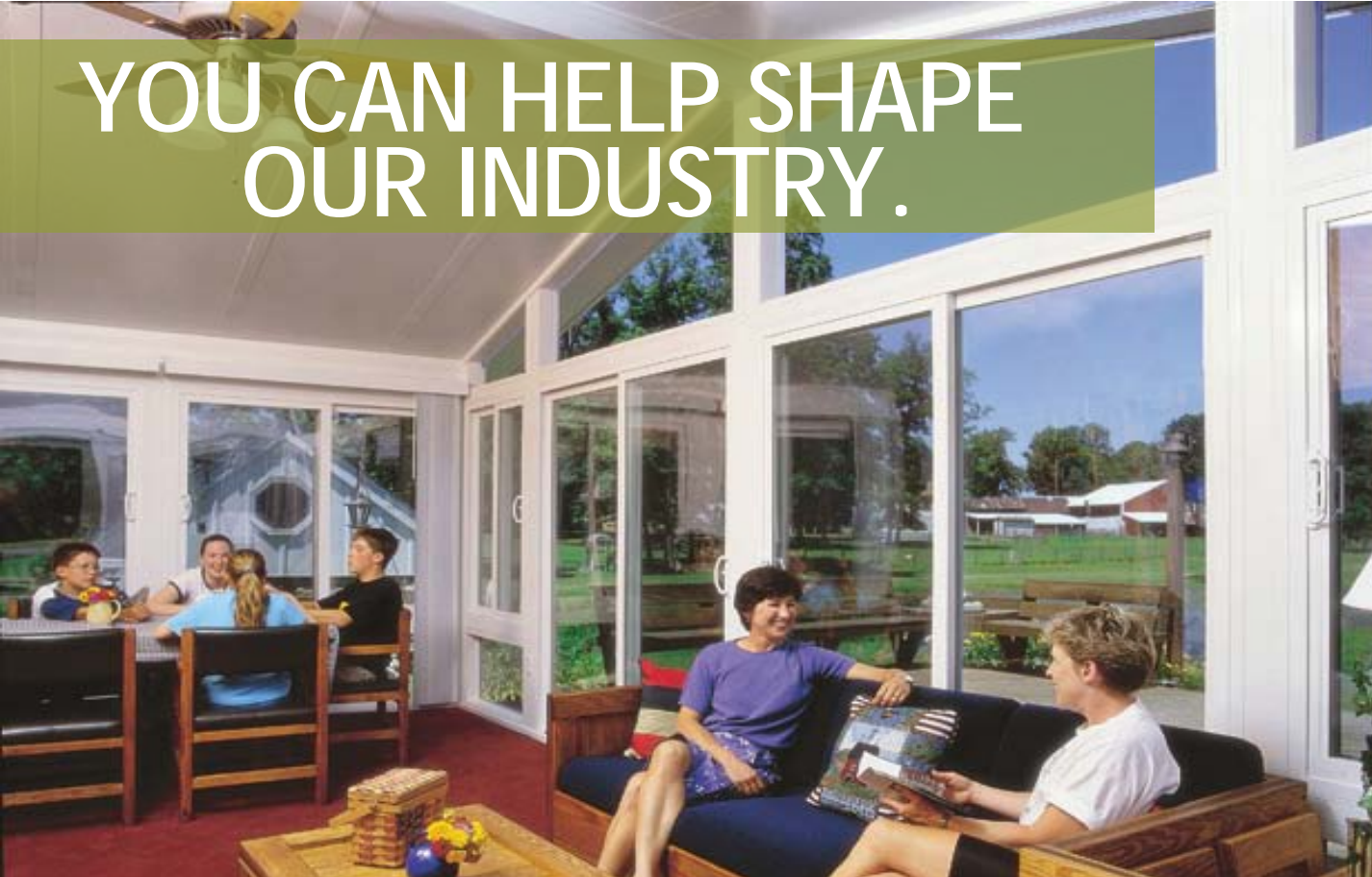
